On July 2, 2024, at approximately 6:53 PM, the Tioga County Sheriff's Office responded to 6324 State Route 38 in the Town of Newark Valley for a report of a serious motor vehicle crash. The vehicle was traveling northbound on State Route 38 when the vehicle went off the east side of the roadway and struck a mailbox, then a parked vehicle, before coming to rest over an embankment. The operator of the vehicle Max T. Chandler, age 52, succumbed to his injuries; the passenger of the vehicle Glen R. Dillenbeck, age 63, was not injured. The Tioga County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Tioga County Sheriff's Crash Investigation and Drone Units, Newark Valley Fire Department, Campville Fire Department, Maine EMS and New York State Police. The investigation into the crash is ongoing.
